

<p>The coronavirus – what we’re doing, taking into account the changing regulatory health requirements...</p>	<p>...And how you can help</p>
<p>We’re asking that anyone who is feeling unwell, is displaying any symptoms, or who is in quarantine, stays at home and does not visit our premises. Temperature checks will be carried out periodically by a thermal camera located at the entrance hall of our buildings. The COVID Pass is required where it has been made mandatory by the authorities (restaurant, day care, crèche, etc.); this also applies to the special measures applicable to the sports centre.</p>	<p>Please consult a doctor if you have any symptoms, and remain at home if you are infected, suspect that you are, or are in quarantine. Please make sure that your staff, visitors and suppliers do the same. Please play your part by having your temperature taken by a thermal camera located at the entrance hall of our buildings, presenting your Covid Pass where required, and observing the special health measures imposed by the authorities.</p>
<p>We welcome and supervise all our tenants, visitors and suppliers to ensure that safety and precautionary measures are fully complied with.</p>	<p>.Please welcome your tenants, visitors, and suppliers to the building, and supervise them to ensure that safety and precautionary measures are fully complied with.</p>
<p>Hand sanitiser gel is available at entrances and on each floor of our buildings. We are reducing the surfaces you need to touch and/or disinfecting them several times a day, and are using a detection device and a UV lamp to check cleanliness.</p>	<p>Please limit direct contact with surfaces, and sanitise your hands both BEFORE and AFTER touching anything.</p>
<p>We insist that face masks are worn in communal areas, and we’re scrupulous in enforcing hygiene regulations.</p>	<p>.Please wear a face mask in communal areas and ensure that your staff, visitors and suppliers comply with hygiene regulations.</p>
<p>Our maintenance staff regularly check our hand sanitiser dispensers and keep them topped up. Each dispenser has a QR code which you can use to alert them.</p>	<p>.Please inform us of any problems with hand sanitiser dispensers.</p>
<p>Safety and precautionary regulations are displayed throughout the buildings.</p>	<p>Please ensure that everyone complies with the health instructions and safe distancing requirements displayed throughout the premises.</p>
<p>We monitor the quality of the air, make sure it’s constantly renewed, and design, maintain and audit our ventilation systems in collaboration with professional partners.</p>	<p>Please allow air to flow freely, and limit points of contact by keeping non-security doors open. As the building is already ventilated, there is no need to open windows.</p>
<p>Our dining area partners ensure compliance with industry-specific health and safety requirements.</p>	<p>.Please respect the measures in force in our dining areas.</p>
<p>In compliance with government requirements, we have introduced protocols and stringent regulations in specific areas to ensure social distancing and keep users safe. These regulations are displayed throughout the building.</p>	<p>Please observe all protocols and regulations, and follow the instructions in specific areas such as showers, toilets, and changing rooms.</p>
